### **2009 "Kids Are Growing" Greenhouse Contest Rules**

This contest begins on November 24, 2008 and ends on January 30, 2009. Enter to win one of the five "EasyGrow" greenhouse kits and a \$1,000 grant to outfit it. To enter, go online to [www.KING5.com](http://www.KING5.com) and print the entry form, follow instructions as stated on the form and in the rules. **ONLY ONE SUBMISSION PER SCHOOL**, whether it is an individual, classroom or school project. Submissions must be in a 3-ring notebook and contain the completed entry form signed by the school principle or vice principal, acknowledging the validity of the application and willingness to accept the award if selected. Entry submissions should tell us what winning the greenhouse would do for your school and what the students would do and learn from the new resource. Submissions may contain letters, essays, drawings, photos or other media, as long as it can be contained in a 3-ring binder with the entry form. Completed submissions must be mailed to: Kids Are Growing Contest, c/o KING 5 TV, P.O. Box 19640, Seattle, WA 98109. All mail entries must be postmarked by January 30, 2009. No mechanically reproduced entries will be accepted. From all entries received, five (5) winners will be selected by a panel of judges from participating sponsors and KING 5 TV. Submissions will be judged on the basis of originality, creativity and educational value to the students. Winner selection will take place on or around February 13, 2009. Odds of winning shall be determined by the number of eligible entries received.

Each prize is for the entrant's elementary school and consists of: One (1) "EasyGrow" greenhouse kit (assembly required by winner). Greenhouse measures approximately 6 feet wide x 8 feet long after assembly. Also, one (1) \$1,000 grant from the Washington State Potato Commission. Approximate retail value of each greenhouse is \$895 US. Prize packages are not transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash value.

Winners will be notified by phone, US mail and/or overnight courier on or near February 13, 2009. If a winner is unreachable after two (2) business days, an alternate winner will be selected by contest judges from the remaining qualified entries.
